Following will be patched with OgreBot 17.158

While I HIGHLY advise against having characters with the same name on different servers, I have added some minor support, specifically into 'ogre login'.

You put ONE entry into your eq2chars per character name (even if you have more than 1 toon with that same name). Which ever server name you enter in, will be the default.

For example, I entered in: Kannkor on server Maj'dul.

That means if I 'ogre login kannkor', it will log in on Maj'dul.

If I make a toon on another server, say skyfire, with the same name, if I want to use this other toon, I can use: ogre login servername.toonname. This supports many abbreviations also.

Example: ogre login skyfire.kannkor

Would log in a toon on skyfire named kannkor.

Likewise, if I created a toon with the same name on AB, I could do:

ogre login ab.kannkor

Here is a list of the abbreviations I added:

md = Maj'dul

hof = Halls of Fate

sf = Skyfire

ab = Antonic Bayle

ior = Isle of Refuge

fg = Fallen Gate

While this adds basic support, at this stage I don't have any plans of going back through all the existing code to support toons with the same name. IE: ogre pg will just use the default character.
