I would like to see the following feature added to ISXBJ Inventory:

If the bot attempts to list an item and the item is not currently listed on the broker, I would like the program to list the item at a pre-determined/user defined markup over the vendor price. The sequence would be something like:

Unlist item for sale.

Search broker.

If item is found on broker, match price.

If item is NOT found on server, list the item for sale. Price = $(VendorPrice)^*(x)$ where x = the predefined markup percentage. I recommend a default of 2 so you can get double what a vendor will pay.

Another user defined value should be added for how to price shinies that are not on the broker. Most shinies sell to the vendor for 1cp, so doubling the price to 2cp and listing it would be a bad idea. The user should be able to define a set price for listing shinies that are not on the broker such as 10pp.
